

The following is a list of the criteria/eligibility requirements for consideration for this position and an explanation of the commitment that will be involved:

Criteria for Eligibility: (The following items are required to be considered for Regional Ambassador)

1. Full Member of LPNAN
2. LPN license
3. Reside in the region in which applying for Regional Ambassador
4. Have access to a phone
5. Ability to travel within the state to attend Board of Director Meetings

Applications will be reviewed with the following additional criteria in mind:

1. Community involvement (if applicable)
2. Personal goals
3. Neatness, spelling, and grammar.

Commitment for a Regional Ambassador includes serving on the Board of Directors, which meets 4-5 times per year (usually in Kearney, site of Retreat, site of convention, and in Lincoln). The position is for a two-year term. A Regional Ambassador must be willing to host one meeting per year in their own region and serve as the information resource for that region. Regional Ambassadors may appoint an Alternate to help them within their region and/or fill in for them at Board of Director meetings if necessary.
