Vaccine Differences & Similarities

Efficacy in Preventing any Severity in Phase Three Clinical Trials:

- The Pfizer vaccine had 95% efficacy.
- The Moderna vaccine had 94% efficacy.
- The Johnson & Johnson vaccine had 66% efficacy (in trials with variants).

- Comparatively, the flu vaccine is generally 40 to 60% effective.

Each of these vaccines had 100% efficacy against COVID-related hospitalizations and deaths.

Number of Doses Required:

- Both Pfizer and Moderna require two doses.
- Johnson and Johnson only requires one dose.
