FUNDING FOR NF & AL

STATE

- Community CARES Stabilization Round Two Grant Program
- Must apply by **Nov. 13** – first come, first served
- Funding based on bed number – approximately \$25,000-30,000 per facility
- Can apply even if received Round One funds
- Portal open with more information on **Oct. 21 at 10:00am:**

FEDERAL

- Provider Relief Fund applications accepted through **Nov. 6**
- If funds not used up to 2%, then additional funds awarded

INFLUENZA

- Expect additional oversight of # of residents & staff receiving vaccine
- Encourage participation ... and document
- NHSN reporting optional
