Directed Health Measures	Your safety and well-being are NHCA's top priority. The event will follow Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department directed health measures (DHMs) in place at the time the event is held.
Content	This program will discuss the most common life safety deficiencies for long-term care and assisted living facilities in Nebraska. The minimum required inspection, testing, and maintenance activities that need to be performed on a facility's fire protection systems to meet requirements will be discussed.
Objectives	At the completion of this training, participants will be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Understand the top life safety deficiencies in Nebraska2. Explain what regular inspection, testing, and maintenance requirements apply to a facility3. Identify what inspection, testing, and maintenance aspects can be performed by facility personnel and what needs to be done by licensed contractors4. List two updates to the Life Safety Code for nursing facilities and assisted living facilities5. Describe emergency preparedness for wildfire and floods for long-term care.
