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CONTENT

Participants will develop an understanding of current and future changes impacting reimbursement, including Medicaid and Medicare. Nursing facilities will understand the Requirements of Participation Phase 3, which goes into effect November 2019, and LB439, which will continue to impact assisted living communities. Participants will also understand the importance of continuing to build relationships with their elected officials.

OBJECTIVES

1. Learners will review and discuss changes to Medicaid, Medicare, and managed care reimbursement, including the impact on nursing facility and assisted living funding.
2. Learners will review and discuss changes to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services regulations, survey process and practices, and policies impacting nursing facilities and assisted living communities.
3. Learners will review and discuss the Nebraska legislative process, including an update on what is happening in the legislature and the role of political action committees.
4. Learners will review and discuss Quality Initiatives and tools for use in assisted living and nursing facilities including the Quality Award program and Long-Term Care Trend Tracker.
